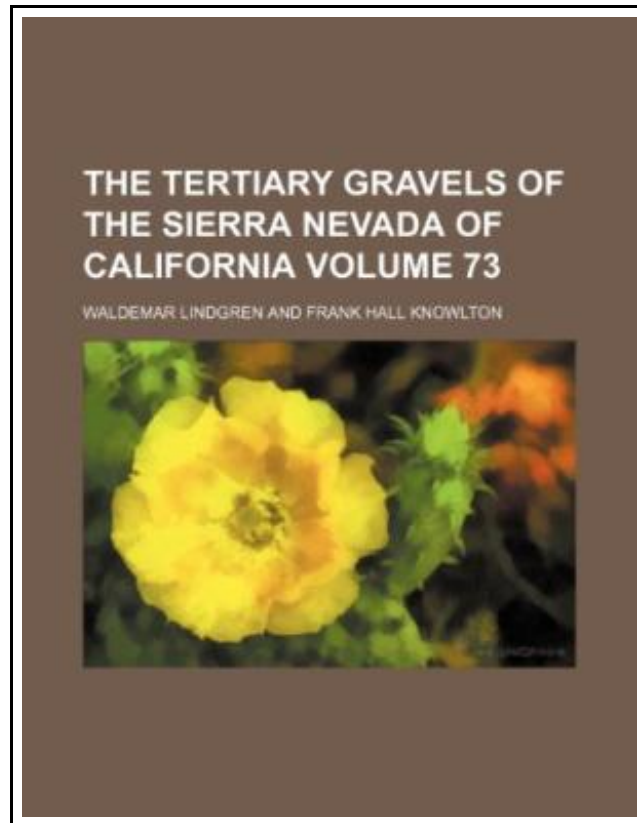

As far down as English Lake tius channel does not seem to have contained any large amount of gravel. The writer still believes that the drainage during the intervolcanic epoch had that direction, but it seems very possible that the early Neocene drainage continued parallel and to the east of the Neocene divide across the gap north of Milton and by Chips Hill to Haskell Peak and farther north. In that case the old stream bed has been considerably deformed, for the gap north of Milton has an elevation of over 6, 100 feet; Chips Hill, as stated, reaches 6, 500 feet and Haskell Peak 7, 000 feet, while the elevation of the deepest point of the rhyolite flow between English Lake and Milton is only 6, 000 feet. If the channel existed as outlined a sharp tilt must have taken place between Milton and Haskell Peak, reversing the grade. Then the channel was cut by the great Mohawk fault and dropped about 2, 000 feet. From Mohawk Valley northward another reversal of grade, more gentle than the first, must have occurred. The stream flowed throughout in a deep valley, the sides of which rise in places over 1, 000 feet above the channel. No detailed description of the auriferous gravels in the present stream beds will be given here. Most of them were worked out long ago, and the richest regions were those in which the Neocene channels have later...
